

Dear Parents/Carers,

Ahead of the last few weeks of term, I wanted to write to you to ensure you all know what is happening each week in Year 6 as it is a very busy few weeks!

Wednesday 5th July is cooking day (this has been changed from 28th June). Please ensure that all children bring a container and £1 into school.

Friday 7th July is Year 6's final school disco 5.30-6.30pm.

Tuesday 11th July the nurse will be visiting to talk to both the girls and boys separately about growing up. (See previous separate letter).

Thursday 13th and Friday 14th July are the Year 6 performances. Please can all children return to school at 6pm. The performances will start at 6.30pm. All children will be ready for collection at 8pm. Please ensure that your child attends both evenings. (E-mail with ticket details was sent yesterday).

Monday 17th July is careers day in school. This will be an opportunity for children to hear about different careers. Leaver's hoodies can also be worn from this day.

Thursday 20th July will be an additional Forest Schools day. Please can children come to school in suitable clothes and a change of footwear.

Friday 21st July children are going bowling which is kindly paid for by the HSA. Children are to come into school in their own clothes at normal time (a form asking for you to give permission for bowling was sent yesterday). Children can remain in their own clothes once back at school. During the afternoon, the children will be going down to the forest area. Please bring some suitable shoes and a change of clothing if required.

On Monday 24th July reports will be given out at end of the day which will include SATs results. Open evening is from 3:30p.m. -5:00p.m. Children's books will be out for you to look at.

On Tuesday 25th July children can bring in a spare shirt to get signed throughout the day. The shirt they are wearing is not to be signed.
