

## Thank you for your feedback

I would like to share with you the feedback that parents shared with us, after the children's end of year reports were received in July, as we completed the 21-22 academic year.

**93%** of parents stated that they were happy with their child's report.

**94%** of parents stated that they knew about their child's learning and progress from the 21-22 academic year.

**84%** of parents stated that they felt their child had closed their gaps in learning from the pandemic.

Suggestions made that will be considered this year:

- *Information in SATS sheets is difficult to navigate. Either needs a clear explanation or the irrelevant parts to be removed.*
- *Information about how they Interact socially.*
- *Suggestions of how we can help to achieve "expected" ready for the next year group.*
- *Information about specific SEND provision that has taken place. Including information about measurable progress that has taken place.*
