Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child is bringing home their first Set 1 speed sounds booklet today. This is to help them practise their sounds at home, alongside having a go at practising writing them.

Please do not worry about completing the whole booklet too soon. In class we have reached 'k'. I would suggest practising a couple of sounds each week, rather than trying to do too many at once.

The children also now have their log in details for the Oxford Owl RWI ebook library. You will be able to find these details in the front of your child's planner. Once you log in you will find the activity within the 'homework' tab. There will be one new activity uploaded to this tab each week, and we will begin by focussing on the initial sounds blending quizzes, in readiness for reading books with cvc words.

These additional resources are to go alongside the QR codes, where you can practise one of the sounds which your child has learnt, in the same way as they are taught in class, as well as the reading books which are sent home weekly.

Please feel free to write down in your child's planner any reading, including phonics practise, which your child does at home. This can include any of your own books also, not only the ones provided by school.

We hope your child enjoys their speed sounds booklet and the e-book library, alongside the QR code videos and reading books.
